#### HOUSE RULE HIGHLIGHTS

- NO Smoking on the property
- No pets
- Slippers (or "inside shoes") required to protect softwood floors.
- × No skis or poles in lodge
- Hallways must be kept clear
- Basement door is locked. Key is on key rack next to Bulletin Board when access is needed.
- Keys for suites must be left on key rack when you are out.



## INNKEEPER

- × Gets free bed
- Provides continental breakfast food for weekend
- Is in charge to see the effective operation of weekend
- Is a volunteer who has been qualified by the Lodge Committee
- Please cooperate if innkeeper asks for your help.



# **CLEANING**

- Cleaning Service:
  - + Comes once per week during season
  - + Cleans common areas including bathrooms and kitchen
- \* We need to:
  - + Clean up after ourselves. That means wash and put away your dishes, etc.
  - + Empty the trash can in your room when you check out.
- If you are able to, volunteer to take the kitchen trash & recyclables to dumpster



### SECURITY

- All outside doors must be locked when you leave the lodge
- All main lodge doors are auto locked from outside when shut
- Suite doors must be checked
- Be sure gas is turned off on stoves and gas fireplace. Knob on stove must be "popped out".



#### POSSIBLE PROBLEMS

- For sprinkler malfunction—call 911 and/ or the sprinkler vendor, Life Safety
- For heat failure—call Irving Oil (see Contact list).
- The Alarm box by front door beeps. Normally due to communication trouble. Call alarm company number on control box...silence alarm.





#### POSSIBLE PROBLEMS

- Cable/ internet out call Comcast # in lodge info book.
- Electrical circuit breaker box in dining room, another in basement



#### KITCHEN SMOKE

- Reduce chances of this problem by not leaving stovetop cooking unattended.
- Assure the door to kitchen is kept clear, so if there is smoke, the door will auto close.
- When the smoke detector in kitchen sounds, the door will close.
- Solve the problem and open the window from top and bottom.



#### KITCHEN SMOKE

- Put window fan in the top section of the window.
- \* Turn fan on to blow out.
- Assure that bottom section is open too.
- Leave door closed
